

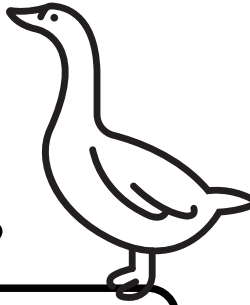

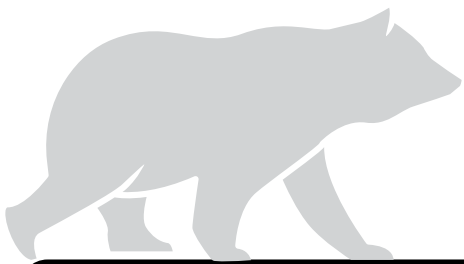

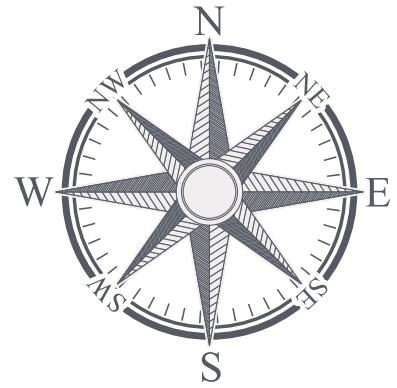


What does it mean that God is sovereign?

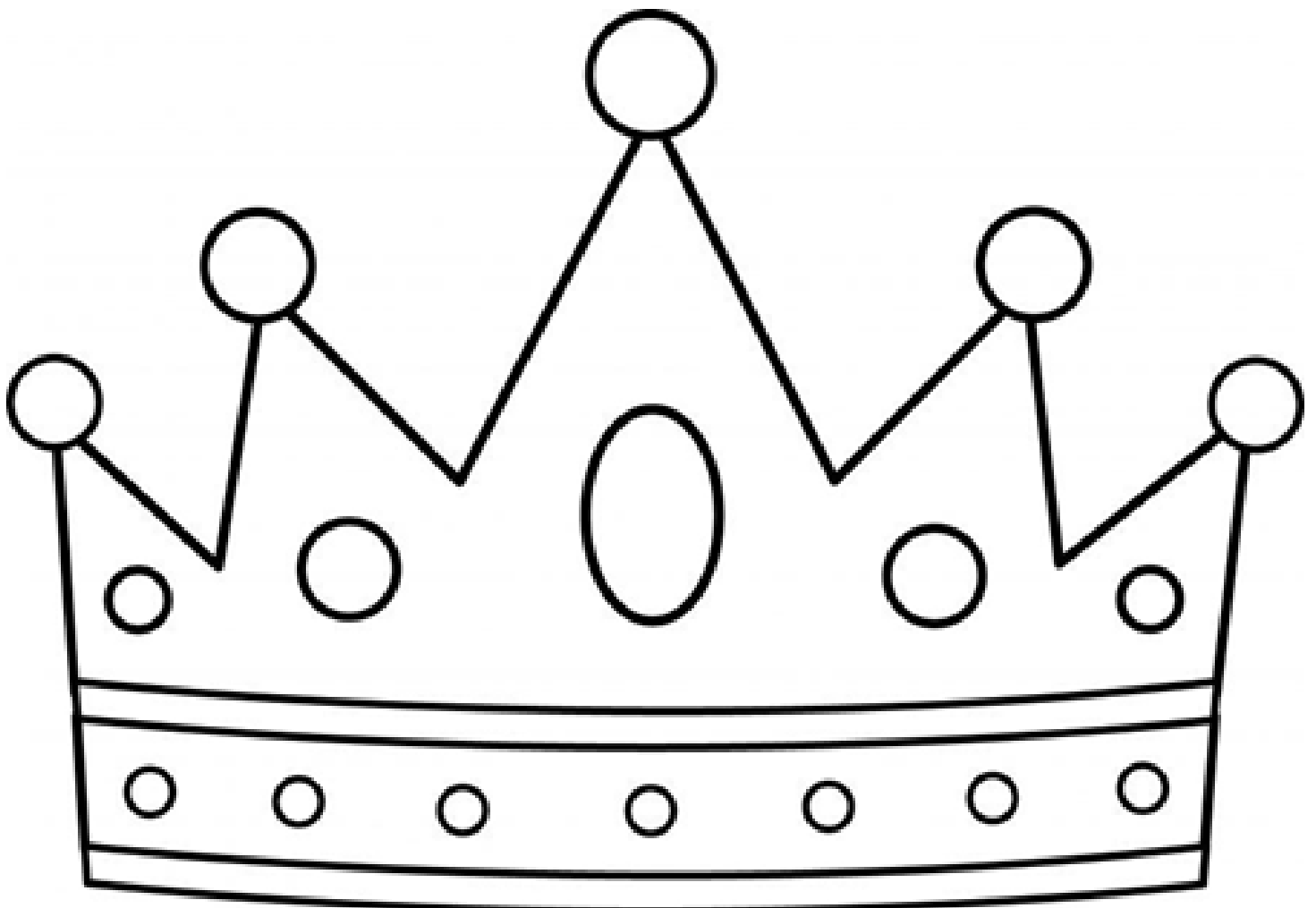


In verse 30 of our passage, King Nebuchadnezzar thought he was great. How has God changed his mind in verses 34 to 35?

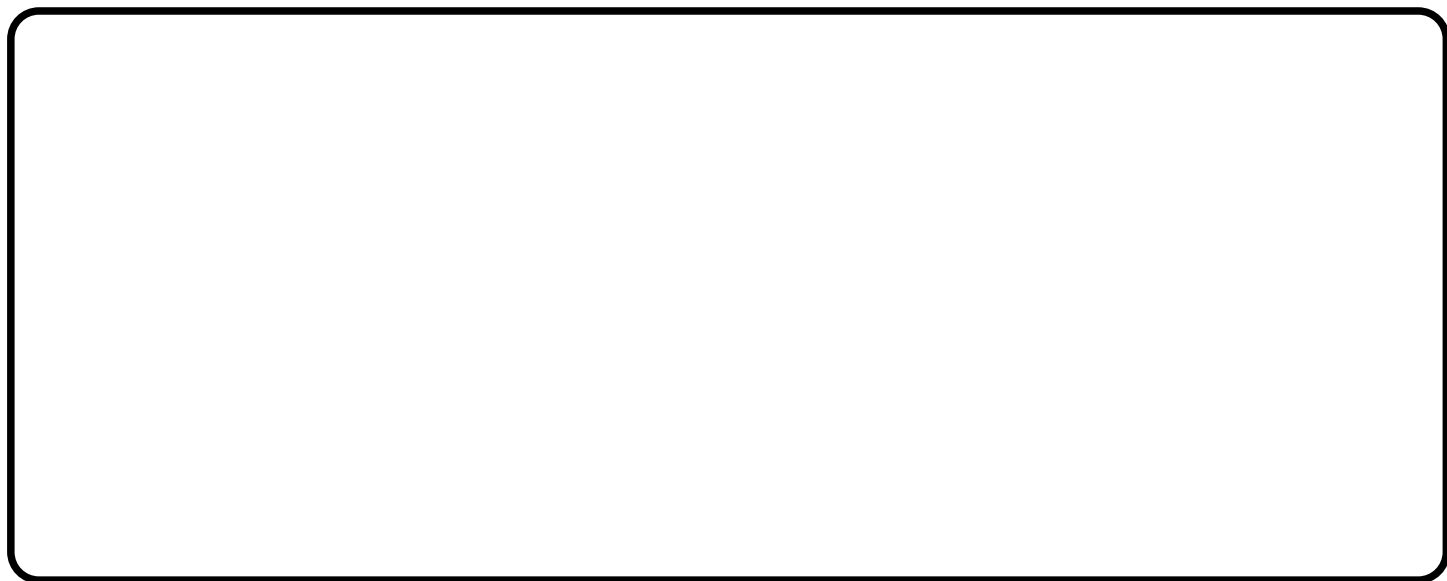
Which words in the passage mention God's kingdom? For example heaven. Watch out: there may be other words that mean the same thing!

Colour in the crown



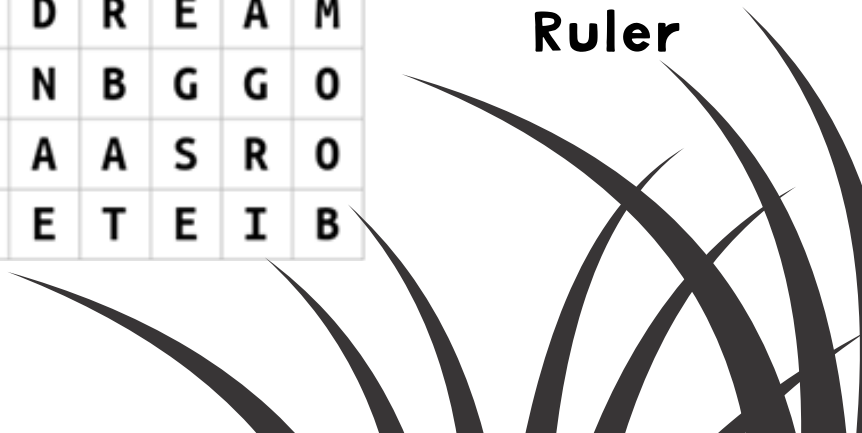
Try to think of some of your favourite things that God has made. Draw a picture of them.
