Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by ministering to children and ensuring under 4's have a positive early experience of church

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting: Sundays, 9am set up for 10am service
2. How often do we meet? Weekly
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 1-2 hours
4. What is the role of a volunteer? Lead, and/or assist to lead a roughly 45-minute session for the 1-4 year olds on a Sunday morning, including planning the session using provided material, setting up the room before hand, and packing it down at the end, as well as overseeing the youth volunteers who serve on the team each week.
5. Is preparation required for meetings? Yes, if leading. (It's expected that all volunteers will take turns to lead sessions throughout the term)
6. What training is provided? Ongoing Children's Ministry Training Evenings, and occasional day conferences throughout the year
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? Yes

Spiritual Gifts <i>(see eg Romans 12:3-8)</i>	Patience, gentleness
Heart for... <i>(zeal for a need or cause)</i>	Serving young children, growing faith in children
Abilities/skills <i>(from education, work or life)</i>	Communication with young children, willingness to play and imagination to initiate games
Personality <i>(extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)</i>	Able to work with a team, enthusiastic
Experiences <i>(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)</i>	Experience working with young children may help, but not required
