Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by enabling the whole church family to learn from God and worship him together

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting: Sundays, slot within the 10am service.
2. How often do we meet? Weekly
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? Up to 1 hour
4. What is the role of a volunteer? Plan and lead a 5-10 minute all age slot in the morning service, using the series plan provided. Volunteers lead approximately once per term
5. Is preparation required for meetings? Yes.
6. What training is provided? Ongoing Children's Ministry Training Evenings, and occasional day conferences throughout the year
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No

Spiritual Gifts <i>(see eg Romans 12:3-8)</i>	Teaching
Heart for... <i>(zeal for a need or cause)</i>	Growing the whole church family together, worshipping God together, teaching the word of God clearly and faithfully
Abilities/skills <i>(from education, work or life)</i>	Communication and public speaking, communicate the Bible in accessible ways, good knowledge of the Bible/theology
Personality <i>(extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)</i>	Extroverted and comfortable with being "up front" at church. Willingness to make a fool out of themselves if desired
Experiences <i>(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)</i>	Experience working with children or youth, or in "up front" bible teaching may be useful, but not required
