Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by reaching out to youth with the good news of Jesus, both from the local area, and church families and their friends

What the role involves

- Time and day of team activity or meeting: Thursdays, 6.30pm set up for 7-9pm club, plus pack down.
- 2. How often do we meet? Weekly
- 3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 2-3 hours
- 4. What is the role of a volunteer? Lead, and/or assist to lead the youth club including serving refreshments, playing video games and board games, playing football or other active games, and facilitating a 30min bible teaching time (either by doing the teaching, or helping the children to listen and engage).
- 5. Is preparation required for meetings? Yes, if leading. (Most volunteers will take turns to lead sessions throughout the term)
- 6. What training is provided? Ongoing Children's Ministry Training Evenings, and occasional day conferences throughout the year
- 7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? Yes
