Purpose of the ministry

In addition to Sunday services, at Holy Trinity, we seek and to know Christ better and make Him known amongst our 14-18s, including those who attend church regularly, and those from our local area who do not.

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting: Sundays, 7.30pm meet after evening service, for 7.45-9.15pm club, followed by pack-down
2. How often do we meet? Weekly
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 2-3 hours
4. What is the role of a volunteer? Lead, and/or assist to lead CYFA, including playing a variety of games, engaging in conversation, sharing a meal with them, and facilitating bible teaching time (either by doing, or helping the youth to listen and engage).
5. Is preparation required for meetings? Yes. Most volunteers will take turns to lead sessions, though we encourage all leaders to look through the teaching plans beforehand.
6. What training is provided? Ongoing Children's Ministry Training Evenings, termly Pathfinders/CYFA team meeting and occasional day conferences throughout the year
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? Yes
