Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by livestreaming the services to those unable or unwilling to come into the church buildings.

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting The main responsibility is to stream a service, typically once a month. There is no regular meeting for the team, but very occasional ad hoc ones may be arranged.
2. How often do we meet? Other
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 2-3 hours
4. What is the role of a volunteer? To run the livestream during a service. This means arriving 45 minutes before the start of the service.
5. Is preparation required for meetings? No
6. What training is provided? Full 1:1 training will be provided.
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No
