

## Music Team Volunteer Profile

### Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by facilitating sung worship in our weekly church meetings. This enables the church to encounter bible truths and commit them to heart.

### What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting: Sunday mornings and evening, 1 hour before the service
2. How often do we meet? You'd be rota'd for one service a month, or less frequently
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 1 hour practice before serving
4. What is the role of a volunteer? Playing an instrument or singing - not as a performance, but to lead church to a heart of worship
5. Is preparation required for meetings? Yes - checking over and possibly practising songs at home in the week before serving
6. What training is provided? No musical training, but band leadership is provided by the band leader.
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No

### Typical "SHAPE" Profile

Sometimes a certain kind of person is better suited to one role than to another. What might a typical volunteer look like in this area of serving?

<b>Spiritual Gifts</b> <i>(see eg Romans 12:3-8)</i>	Humility.
<b>Heart for...</b> <i>(zeal for a need or cause)</i>	Praise, worship, musical expression.
<b>Abilities/skills</b> <i>(from education, work or life)</i>	At least moderate ability with an instrument, or the ability to sing in tune and in time.
<b>Personality</b> <i>(extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)</i>	Keen to listen to the band leader and the rest of the band - team player.
<b>Experiences</b> <i>(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)</i>	Although not essential, it helps if you've played in a band or group before, especially at church.
