Personality <i>(extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)</i>	<p>Outgoing, friendly and cheerful. Any inter-action with people within work or personal life.</p>
Experiences <i>(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)</i>	<p>Any inter-action with people within work or personal life.</p>
