Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by ensuring a warm welcome for all who come to church and by setting up and clearing away for morning services.

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting: 9.30 start Sunday mornings until end of coffee time after the service (once a month)
2. How often do we meet? Monthly
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? 2-3 hours
4. What is the role of a volunteer? to help set up and clear away for morning meetings as well as maintain a safe and welcoming environment – once a month rota.
5. Is preparation required for meetings? No
6. What training is provided? Support and help from existing stewards and welcome team.
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No

Typical “SHAPE” Profile

Sometimes a certain kind of person is better suited to one role than to another. What might a typical volunteer look like in this area of serving?

<i>Spiritual Gifts</i> <i>(see eg Romans 12:3-8)</i>	Serving and encouragement
<i>Heart for...</i> <i>(zeal for a need or cause)</i>	Making sure everyone coming to church is warmly welcomed and kept safe and secure – maintaining a clean, tidy church.
<i>Abilities/skills</i> <i>(from education, work or life)</i>	Approachable, calm, seeing what needs doing and getting on with it, working as part of a team.
<i>Personality</i> <i>(extrovert/introvert, task or team, detail or big picture)</i>	Reliability and a conscientious approach is more important than a particular personality type.
<i>Experiences</i> <i>(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)</i>	Any interaction with people within work or personal life; experience of looking after things.
