Purpose of the ministry

Within Holy Trinity, we seek to know Christ better and make Him known by serving Him in love and being light and salt in the world. This can be seen through teams serving together in a variety of ways in the church, including practical tasks such as gardening / grounds maintenance.

To look after our church grounds (church and hall areas), which are in need of some regular care and attention.

What the role involves

1. Time and day of team activity or meeting - to be agreed by the group
2. How often do we meet – fortnightly, but can be less regular for those who just want to help as and when
3. How much time commitment is required per meeting? No specific requirement
4. What is the role of a volunteer? To help with gardening and keeping the church grounds neat and tidy.
5. Is preparation required for meetings? No
6. What training is provided? Just mutual support.
7. Is a DBS safeguarding check required? No

(good ones or painful ones if relevant here)

For this role, we are looking for people who are willing to see the church grounds well maintained and loved. There is no particular personality type we are looking for, but obviously you need to have a suitable level of fitness to do any sort of gardening. Any gardening / maintenance skills would be helpful but not essential. The main thing is to be a good team member, willing to serve alongside others in practical ways.
